The MYA Program aims to onboard qualified learners to serve as the Department of Education's (DepEd) ambassadors who will champion the innovative use of technology to their classmates and peers.

I. Guidelines for Application

A. Benefits of the MYA Program

The participants to the program are expected to

1. become youth representatives and be involved in national and international events led/participated by the BLSS-YFD and Microsoft;
2. join the exclusive network of youth ambassadors advocating youth empowerment through technology;
3. receive exclusive mentoring and training sessions on societal (e.g., leadership, communication, etc.) as well as technical and innovation skills.
4. have the opportunity to join training programs for certification;
5. have the opportunity for regional and national recognitions; and
6. receive limited-edition MYA merchandise.

B. Qualifications

The applicants must

1. be enrolled DepEd learners from Junior High School to Senior High School;
2. have an active Office 365 account (learners with no Office 365 accounts may contact their school ICT coordinator);
3. be open to learn as well as cascade the same training to their classmates and peers;
4. be up for the challenge to develop leadership, communication and interpersonal skills
5. have some knowledge on how to use Windows 10/11 devices (desktop or laptop);
6. have some knowledge on how to use Microsoft Office 2019 (Teams, Word, Excel and PowerPoint); and
7. be familiar with and be willing to learn Minecraft: Education Edition.

C. Application Process

1. DepEd learners who are interested to apply must fill out the form at <https://blssyfd.weebly.com/registration.html> from 01 to 15 December 2021. The form must be completed by the applicant and not by someone else.
