AMENDMENT TO DEPED ORDER NO. 030, S. 2020

(Amendment to DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2020, School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021)

- 1. Based on the continuous monitoring by the Department of Education (DepEd) of the implementation of the Basic Education-Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) through the results of formative assessments, portfolio of learning outputs, and other activities given to learners, there has been an identified need to address learning gaps in order to meet the required essential learning competencies. These learning gaps are attributable to reduced academic opportunities at home and substantial loss of live contact with teachers.
- 2. To address the learning gaps and to give additional pedagogical time to teachers for the different learning delivery modalities, the Department issues this Amendment to DepEd Order [DO] No. 030, s. 2020.
- 3. Paragraphs 3 and 4 of DO No. 030, s. 2020 are amended as follows:
 - 3. From March 1 to March 12, 2021, schools shall conduct intervention and remediation activities based on the unique needs of the learners as determined through the results of the different forms of assessments administered for the past two quarters. These intervention and remediation activities shall be indicated in the two-week home learning plan to be prepared by the teachers, with the assistance of the assigned learning support aides (LSAs) as applicable.
 - 4.1 From March 15 to March 19, 2021, teachers shall attend a professional development program through an in-Service Training (INSET) organized by the school or other relevant units of DepEd.
 - 4.2 The schedule for the succeeding quarters shall be adjusted as follows:
 - 4.2.1. Quarter 3 shall be from March 22, 2021 to May 15, 2021

- 4.2.2. Quarter 4 shall be from May 17, 2021 to July 10, 2021
- 4.3 The additional two-week period shall be compensated by a similar adjustment in the school break between SY 2020-21 and SY 2021-2022.
- 4. This policy shall be implemented in all public elementary and secondary schools nationwide for SY 2020-2021. Private schools, technical and vocational institutions, and higher education institutions, including state and local universities and colleges offering the K to 12 Basic Education Program are encouraged to implement these guidelines according to their philosophy, vision, and mission.

AMENDMENT TO DEPED ORDER NO. 007, S. 2020.

- The Office of the President, through the Office of the Executive Secretary, issued a Memorandum dated August 14, 2020 on the decision of President Rodrigo. Roal Duterte upon the recommendation of the Department of Education (DepEd) pursuant to Republic Act No. 11480 (An Act Amending Section 3 of Republic Act No. 7797, Otherwise Known As 'An Act to Lengthen the School Calendar from Two Hundred (200) Days to Not More Than Two Hundred Twenty (220) Class Days) to defer the opening of classes to October 5, 2020.
- 2. In view of this, DepEd amends the provisions of DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2020 titled School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021, Paragraphs 3, 6 and 7 of the policy cover are amended as follows:
 - 3. As decided by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte upon the recommendation of the Department of Education (DepEd) pursuant to Republic Act No. 11480 titled "An Act Amending Section 3 of Republic Act No. 7797. Otherwise Known As "An Act to Lengthen the School Calendar from Two Hundred (200) Days to Not More Than Two Hundred Twenty (220) Class Days", the opening of classes shall be deferred to October 5, 2020. However, the days in September prior to the formal school opening will be used to provide learners with assignments to explore foundational topics for deepening during the year, orientation on the utilization of alternative learning delivery modalities and corresponding learners' materials, and mental health and psychosocial support activities. These preopening activities devoted to the attainment of learning objectives for the school year shall be counted as class days. The school year will end on June 11, 2021;
 - 6. Because of the compressed school year, the Secretary is authorizing the holding of Saturday classes, through the conduct of distance learning activities to be undertaken by learners, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7797, as amended. Should religious considerations prohibit these Saturday activities, they shall be undertaken on Sundays. In all, the total class days in the 2020-2021 school calendar will be 205 days; and
 - 7. The learning intervention for Alternative Learning System (ALS) shall also formally open on October 5, 2020, while the program

duration will depend on the learner's educational background or existing knowledge level prior to enrolling in the ALS program.

- 3 Item V specifically Paragraphs 8, 18, and 32, of the Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020 2021 are amended to read as follows:
 - 8. For SY 2020-2021, schools shall formally start the conduct of teaching learning activities on October 5, 2020 and shall end June 11, 2021. It shall consist of 205 days inclusive of the pre-school year activities, in-service training for teachers/semestral break and conduct of end-of-year rites;
 - 18. Mental health and psychosocial support activities particularly psychological first aid, discussions on the characteristics and effects of the pandemic, orientation on precautionary and preventive measures, such as water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) and other topics related to the COVID-19 pandemic shall be conducted from September 21 to 26, 2020, white orientation/familiarization of learners on the implementation of learning delivery modalities, utilization of learning resources, as well as the accomplishment of the weekly home learning tasks shall be on September 28–October 3, 2020. Physical and mental resilience of learners shall be further developed throughout the school year in accordance with DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2020 titled Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools; and
 - 32. Remedial, advancement and enrichment classes during summer shall begin on Monday, June 14, 2021 and end on Friday, July 23, 2021.
- 4. In addition, the first academic quarter starts on October 5, 2020 and ends on November 28, 2020, the second quarter shall be from December 1, 2020 to February 6, 2021, the third quarter shall be from February 15, 2021 to April 10, 2021, and the fourth quarter shall be from April 12, 2021 to June 5, 2021.
