This is pursuant to CSC Announcement No. 40, series of 2017 (Implementation of Values Restoration Program):

We are the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values, a Civil Society Organization tasked to train Values Restoration Officers (VROs) who will implement the Values Restoration Program (VRP) in the different government departments, agencies, bureaus, offices including government owned and controlled corporations under the Civil Service Announcement No. 40 s. 2017. The Values Restoration Program is the soft-approach to combat the problem of graft and corruption, inefficiency, and broken working relationships between government employees in their workplace. In line with this is the appointment of Values Restoration Officers who are organic employees of your prestigious agency at least two (2) or more from the division office and its units who are either Public Schools District Supervisors, SEPS, EPS, Elementary & Secondary School Principals (Public & Private), Masters Teachers and department heads under your supervision. This, however, requires training prior to their appointment.

The webinar shall be held on 23-26 March 2021 (Batch 82) with a corresponding fee of Php 4,500.00 per participant inclusive of VROTTT manual, the book *Transforming the Nation through Values*, Values pin, and certificates. The online seminar can be chargeable against your MOOE or your local funds; subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

1. Closely collaborate with the Values Restoration Officer (VRO) from the Private Sector for the teaching of the weekly Value Focus during the flag ceremony and 20 minute classroom discussion among the employees of the department or agency;

Effectively arrange the schedule for the classroom discussion so as not to impede the rendition of

effective public service;

3. In the absence of the VRO from the Private Sector, he/she will perform the necessary duties of his or her counterpart VRO from the private sector particularly the teaching of the weekly value focus during the flag ceremony and during the classroom type discussion.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

1. He/she must be of good moral character and active advocate of good governance by modelling it before the other government personnel;

2. He/she is of good conduct based on the evaluation of his/her Head of Office and based on the

judgment and general observation of his/her co-employees in the agency:

3. He/she should have been one of the best performing employees in the government agency and have not been held quilty or liable of non-feasance, misfeasance, or malfeasance in office or of any flagrant violation of laws and reasonable rules and regulations of the agency.

4. He/she must be between 30-60 yaars old.

Comprehensive VRO Trainers' Training Design

I. Rationale:

To efficiently implement the Values Restoration Program in cognizance to CSC Announcement No. 40 series 2017, a VRO must be competently equipped with the skills how to train and empowered with the core values what to teach. Thus, this program is designed to address both concerns by intertwining skills training and values enhancement colloquium.

II. Objectives:

At the end of the program, the participant is able to:

1. Identify the goals and importance in implementing the Values Restoration Program for their respective offices/agencies;

2. Identify the Pili-pino values needed to be enhanced to effectively implement the Values Restoration Program as stipulated in CSC Announcement No. 40, series of 2017;

3. Acquire the necessary training skills to competently conduct VRP in their respective offices/ agencies.

Iil. Course Content:

- 1. An overview of the goals and relevance of Values Restoration Program according to CSC Announcement 40 s. 2017
- Concept briefing of the following (Trainers' Training Course):
