



**Virtual Gabii sa Kabilin 2021**

After the success of last year's digital Gabii sa Kabilin (GSK), we are teaming up with local museums, historians and the National Historical Commission of the Philippines' (NHCP) National Quincentennial Committee (NQC) for another year of free online activities. This year, it will include webinars, exhibits and videos, which will be available every fourth Friday of the month on GSK's Facebook page and YouTube channel.

GSK will also hold a one night only event on April 16 that will include special presentations highlighting on 500-year anniversary of the arrival of Magellan and the birth of Christianity and its impact. Thus, the theme of the event this years is "The Arrival". This is organized in partnership with local museums and heritage sites.

**Balik Bisaya Vlog**

Every third Friday of the month, Casa Gorordo Museum (CGM) will release a fun, engaging and informative video featuring the different cultural and historical aspects of Cebuanos. It aims to promote local culture and heritage to the youth, particularly Cebuanos who were raised abroad who wish to learn more about their roots. It can be viewed on CGM's official Facebook page.

**Cebu Town Features Videos**

This year, Casa Gorordo Museum will continue to promote Cebuano culture and heritage through its Cebu Town Feature videos. The online series, which began last year, features a local town's story every month. It aims to activate pride of place of Cebuanos for one's town.

Videos will be posted on the town's annual fiesta and can be viewed on the museum's official Facebook page. Featured towns for January are Poro (January 15), Cebu City (January 17) and Borbon (January 20).

Casa Gorordo Museum will continue hosting informative webinars focusing on Cebuano culture through its monthly CGM Talks. It invites experts to share their insights on various topics like Cebuano arts, language, and history.
