The Southeast Asian Minister of Education - Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) are allocating six (6) slots for school heads in DepEd for its Online Version of the Southeast Asian School Leadership Program (SEA-SLP) under the SEAMEO Educational Development Fund. Three (3) slots from primary schools and three (3) slots from secondary schools. The program will run from January 25 to March 5, 2021 and will receive an International Certificate of Completion upon complete submission of all the course requirements.

SEA-SLP is designed as a reflective learning journey that will provide our school leaders with the opportunity to reflect back on their experiences, claim the important lessons learned and integrate these into the regular school processes. The solutions which were proven effective need to be replicated, adapted and scaled-up for a stronger, more agile and resilient school system. By the end of this program, our school leaders will be able to confidently respond to this essential question: What important lessons did we learn from this pandemic and how can we evolve as better school leaders than we were before this crisis?
