2022 DIVISIONS SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

TO: All Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 0263, s. 2022 entitled 2022 Regional Schools Press Conference, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, in coordination with the Negros Oriental School Paper Advisers' Association (NOSPAA) announces the conduct of the 2022 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) with the theme, "Empowering Resilient Communities through Campus Journalism" via Limited Face to Face Modality on April 19-21, 2022.
- 2. This undertaking aims to:
 - 2.1 demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - 2.2 sustain advocacy on social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - 2.3 provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in Journalism as a career and those who intend to use skill sets learned through campus journalism to give them a better edge in their chosen career;
 - 2.4 promote responsible journalism, fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - 2.5 enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 3. The DSPC shall hold writing competitions only for the following categories, in consideration of the threat of COVID-19 pandemic:
 - 3.1 News Writing
 - 3.2 Editorial Writing
 - 3.3 Editorial Column Writing
 - 3.4 Editorial Cartooning
 - 3.5 Science Discovery Writing
 - 3.6 Feature Writing
 - 3.7 Sports Writing
 - 3.8 Copyreading and Headline Writing and
 - 3.9 Public Service Announcement Writing

4. Participants to the 2022 DSPC are the following:

- 4.1 The **First Place Winner** in the District Level of the selected individual writing contests in English and Filipino of both elementary and secondary levels;
- 4.2 The winning School Paper Advisers/Coaches of the identified contests;
- 4.3 Board of judges, resource speakers, identified division personnel and NOSPAA technical working group.
- 5. Other campus journalism categories are withheld due to the threat of COVID-19 pandemic.
- 6. Districts are encouraged to hold their district level selection to arrive at a top winner per category, per level, per medium. For example:

Siaton 1 Feature Writing English (Secondary) = Only 1 Winner

The same holds true to the rest of the categories. These top winners are the official contestants of the district for the DSPC.

- 7. CJs participants are strongly encouraged to get fully vaccinated prior to the activity. On the other hand, all SPAs, coaches, ICT coordinators and TWG who will be indirectly or directly involved should be fully vaccinated or a holder of negative RT-PCR/antigen.
- 8. Only learners and SPAs from schools with school paper (soft or hard copy), published in the previous SY 2020-2021 or current school year either in English or Filipino (not necessarily following the specifications for school paper contest) are allowed to compete in the various individual contests.
- 9. For this School Year, in consideration of the stringent COVID-19 prevention protocols, the DSPC shall be held by congressional areas, with the following hosts:

8.1 First Congressional Level Ayungon 2 8.2 Second Congressional Level Amlan 8.3 Third Congressional Level Siaton 3

The management team and TWG will coordinate with these host districts to gather contestants who will undergo a lecture prior to the contest proper. Please refer to Enclosure Number 2 for the schedule. The speakers and facilitators of the contest categories are seasoned SPAs of the division.

The TWG, in coordination with the speaker-judges, will gather all the outputs per category, per medium, per level and arrive at **Top 3 winners** who will represent the division to the Regional Schools Press Conference.

- 10. Upon registration, SPAs should present the following:
 - 10.1 Learner's Parental Consent
 - 10.2 Medical Certificate of the CJs and the SPAs
 - 10.3 One copy of the School Paper

- 11. A registration fee of P150.00 shall be collected from each participant to defray expenses of the conduct of the activity. Registration, food, travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants and their coaches shall be charged against school MOOE/local funds/standing journalism funds from previous years subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations. All travel, meals and other incidental expenses of the management team, including token of judges and resource speakers shall be charged against NOSPAA funds, subject to liquidation and financial reporting.
