**DIVISION ENHANCED BASIC EDUCATION LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN
PRESENTATION AND LAUNCHING OF THE COMMUNITY ACADEMIC PANTRY**


1. This Division continues its desire to provide quality education to all the learners despite the challenges of times brought about by the pandemic. True to its goal of pursuing education in the new normal, issues which were identified in the previous year were given priority in its intervention plans.
2. One of the intervention plans which tries to address issues related to the distribution and retrieval of modules, provision of teacher instructional support for competencies which need physical presence of the teachers, parents who are literacy and numeracy challenged, thus cannot facilitate instructional support to their children, and even on serving the underserved learners thru video-based lessons where gadgets and facilities were unavailable at home, is to bring education closer to the community thru a hub where learning resources are available. Moreover, this will also allow more engagement among community stakeholders to provide strong support in the academic programs in education. Further, this will also foster learning togetherness between parents and learners most especially to the parents or guardians who are challenged in terms of literacy level. This intervention plan named as "Community Academic Pantry" will be launched on **September 9, 2021 at 10:00 o'clock in the morning in Negros Oriental High School.**
3. Due to heightened restrictions, participants to this activity are limited which include CID and SGOD personnel, PSDSs/In-Charge/Caretaker, Section Heads, select school heads and teachers, and staff with assigned tasks. This will ensure that minimum health protocols are observed. Thus, everyone is expected to follow the health protocols.
4. The event can be viewed to all the division teaching and non-teaching personnel on September 10, 2021 thru our DepEd Tayo SDO Negros Oriental fb page at 9:00 o'clock in the morning.



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5. In preparation for the said activity, select school personnel thru the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) and School Heads are requested to provide support.
6. Major expenses for the said activity like meals of the identified attendees and technical working group, rentals of equipment, and other materials are charged against OSEC-7-20-0865 (Implementation of BE-LCP and Provision of Learning Resources) while meals and expenses of the host school, travel, incidental and other related expenses of the participants, in preparation and during the conduct of the activity are charged against Division/School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
7. This serves as travel order for the division based personnel while the PSDSs and School Heads are requested to provide travel authority to the school-based personnel involved.
