

**INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP DAY**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Every year the third Saturday of September is marked as the International Coastal Cleanup Day. This year will be celebrated on September 18, 2021. The purpose of the cleanup is to engage people around the world to remove trash and debris from beaches and waterways, identify the sources of the litter, and change the behaviors that cause pollution.
2. As per study, there are around 5.25 trillion pieces of plastic debris in the ocean. This is one factor that destroy our marine sanctuary wherein some of the fisherfolks in our country rely solely in fishing as a means of their livelihood.
3. In view of the pressing global concerns and issues on the environment, the Department of Education (DepEd) RO7 invites all Division Offices and schools to encourage personnel and learners to conduct coastal/river/waterways clean-up at their respective home/locality as an advocacy activity to help clean and promote this program on September 18, 2021. It is also requested that all collected plastics or non-biodegradable waste must be weighed and take picture as a means of verification (MOV) of the activity. However, all collected must be turned over to garbage collector for proper disposal.

Furthermore, this Office encourage all Division Offices and schools to support and promote SAL on ECO BIKER's (Sustainable, Advocacies with Love on Environmental Conservation Outreach in Biodiversity, Interactive, Knowledge-provider, Education to Reduce-Reuse-Recycle-Reforest) as our strategic action on Climate Change problem in our country especially in Central Visayas. This initiative encourages DepEd Region 7 personnel, learners, and stakeholders to use bikes as a means of transportation from respective residence to the office/school and vice versa especially on the conduct of outreach activities.
