Guidelines for Areas under Alert Level 4

Who are not allowed outside their respective residences?	persons below 18 years old and over 65 years old; people with immunodeficiencies, comorbidities, and other health risks; pregnant women
Individual outdoor exercises	allowed for all ages regardless of comorbidities or vaccination status but only within the area of residence; minimum health protocol must be observed
Establishments	The following are NOT ALLOWED to operate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • indoor tourist attractions, libraries, archives, museums, and exhibits • indoor venues for meetings, conferences, and events • indoor entertainment venues (e.g., cinemas) and venues with live performers • indoor and outdoor amusement parks, peryas, and kid amusement industries • indoor recreational venues (internet cafes, bowling alleys, billiard halls, etc.) • casinos, cockpits, lottery, and other gaming establishments except those authorized by IATF and/or Office of the President • indoor sports court/venues, fitness studios, gyms, spas or other indoor leisure centers, swimming pools
Activities	The following activities are NOT ALLOWED to be undertaken: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • social events • limited face-to-face classes and other education-related activities except those that are previously allowed by IATF and/or Office of the President • contact sports except those conducted under bubble-type setup • staycations
Dine-in services	maximum of 30% of seating capacity for outdoor/al fresco dine-in services and an additional 10% seating capacity for indoor dine-in services for fully-vaccinated individuals
Personal care services (barbershops, hair spas, nail spas, and beauty salons)	maximum of 30% of seating capacity for outdoor services regardless of vaccination status and an additional 10% seating capacity for indoor services for fully-vaccinated individuals
Religious gatherings	maximum of 30% of seating capacity if conducted outdoors and an additional 10% seating capacity for fully-vaccinated individuals
Necrological services, wakes, inurnment, funerals	allowed but limited to immediate family members and shall comply with the minimum health standards
Intrazonal and interzonal travels	allowed for those who are not required to remain at their residences, subject to the regulations of the LGU of destination
Government offices	fully operational and shall adhere to at least 20% on-site capacity
