Part of the development of the international agenda project is to conduct need assessments and gap analysis. The ICO together with the highly technical consultants will conduct an Online Survey for the Bureau and Service Offices, Regional Offices, and Schools.
- 2. The departments' international agenda for basic education envisions to set a unified and holistic direction in promoting the Philippine basic education agenda among the ministries of education in the region and beyond. It will further assess the ongoing internationalization activities and partnerships as well as the best practices among stakeholders. Hence, the needs assessment and gap analysis will put forward the plans, targets, and reforms that the department may adopt relevant to the objective of pursuing internationalization of the basic education system and the direction that it is likely to take place.
