

Per RM 523 s. 2020 entitled **Guidelines on the Administration of Contextualized ECD Checklist**, the checklist shall be administered to all kindergarten learners at the beginning of the school year (pre-test), and before the school year ends (post-test), adopting either of the delivery options (onsite/offsite) depending on the local COVID-19 risk severity classification.
