WHEREAS, the Regional Development Council (RDC) Resolution No.2 series of 2019 enjoins all provincial and city local government units to establish a well-coordinated statistical system at the local level;

WHEREAS, during the 2nd meeting of the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) on 22 May 2019, one of the topics discussed was the establishment of Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC);

WHEREAS, following these, Governor Roel R. Degamo issued Executive Order No. 45 establishing the PSC of Negros Oriental as provincial counterpart of the Regional Statistics Committees (RSCs) and the PSA Board;

WHEREAS, the members of the Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC) was first convened on 12 May 2021 and one of the topics discussed was the creation of the City/Municipal Statistics Committees to formulate statistical policies at their level designed to resolve local statistical issues and recommend to government entities at the provincial level a workable scheme towards the improvement of city/municipal level statistics;

WHEREAS, the members of the Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC) saw the need to establish City/Municipal Statistics Committees to address the need to have a well-coordinated statistical system at the local level capable of generating statistics which can be integrated and harmonized with statistics being produced at the national level and to be responsive to planning and monitoring requirements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to enjoin the cities and municipalities to establish the City/Municipal Statistics Committee in their level;

RESOLVED FURTHER; that the composition of the City/Municipal Statistics Committee be patterned to the composition stipulated in the Executive Order 45;

WHEREAS, as provincial counterpart of the RSC, Section 5 of EO 45 stipulated that PSC meetings shall convene a month prior to the RSC's quarterly meetings to ensure that unsettled PSC issues that need to be elevated to the RSC are addressed swiftly, whenever necessary;

WHEREAS, the PPA will serve as an important tool in economic planning and policy formulation in the province of Negros Oriental;

WHEREAS, during the 3rd Quarter meeting of the Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC) on 21 July 2021, one of the topics discussed was to enjoin all government agencies, LGUs and private sector to assist and support the PSA in the estimation of the Provincial Product Accounts in Negros Oriental;

WHEREAS, the estimation of the PPA will need data support, strong coordination and partnership with government agencies, LGUs and the private sector in order to be successful;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enjoin all government agencies, LGUs and the private sector to assist and support the PSA in the estimation of the Provincial Product Accounts (PPA) in Negros Oriental;

ENJOINING THE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, LGUS AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) IN DAUIN, NEGROS ORIENTAL AS PILOT LGU

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11315, otherwise known as the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Act approved on 17 April 2019, and the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) signed on 20 May 2020, as part of the government's effort to lift Filipinos out of poverty, and designating the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) as the lead agency in the CBMS implementation;

WHEREAS, the Regional Statistics Committee passed RSC Resolution No. 8, series of 2020, "Requesting the Philippine Statistics Authority to include Central Visayas as one of the Pilot Areas for the CBMS";

WHEREAS, the PSA Central Office, and advised the RSC Central Visayas through PSA Regional Statistical Services Office 7 of its criteria for selection of LGUs where the CBMS can be piloted, to wit: (1) 4th income class municipality, (2) no CBMS experience, and (3) coastal community or island barangay;

WHEREAS, the PSA Regional Statistical Services Office 7 upon the recommendation of the PSA Negros Oriental Office, identified LGU Dauin as suitable for the CBMS pilot;

WHEREAS, LGU Dauin accepted the invitation to be the region's pilot area for CBMS through a letter dated 11 January 2021;

WHEREAS, during the 3rd Quarter meeting of the Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC) Negros Oriental on 21 July 2021, one of the topics discussed was to enjoin all government agencies, LGUs and the private sector to assist and support the PSA in the implementation of the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) in Dauin, Negros Oriental as pilot LGU;




