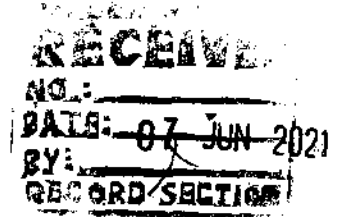

SIR/MADAM:

Warm greetings from the College of Teacher Education, NORSU-MC 1. I hope this letter finds you well.

One of the teaching-learning tasks of student teachers in the new normal is observing the teaching-learning process in Flexible Learning and in different Distance Learning Delivery Modes (online/ radio-based instruction/Television-based instruction/other modalities as practiced in the Department of Education specifically in the schools which they will be assigned to. While the original request was for CPE student teachers to conduct online classes, there is no other viable option since they are all working and thus needed to be assigned to a school with night classes.

As such, this office expresses its full concurrence to the suggested modifications stated in your last letter in the conduct of Student Teaching Internship for CPE students who will be deployed to Sibulan National High School, to wit:

1. that the main learning delivery mode of the said school is Distance Learning through printed modules;
2. that the student teachers shall be present in school during the distribution and retrieval of modules;
3. that other tasks related to modular learning such as house visitation for follow-ups or reinforcement may be assigned to them; and
4. that the deployment schedule will be from **June 9, 2021- July 2, 2021** instead of its original request which was from May 31, 2021-July 2, 2021.

The CPE student teachers have also expressed their concurrence as reflected in their attached forms. I hope that this concurrence will merit your approval so that the student teachers can finally be deployed and have their firsthand experience of teaching in the new normal.
