





The Department of Education, in partnership with the Philippine-American Academy of Science and Engineering (PAASE) and Unilab Foundation, Inc. (ULF) announces the conduct of the National STEM Bee Program.

The National STEM Bee Program is an after-school online intervention program that aims to improve Filipino Students' STEM Competencies as it will train and mentor STEM coaches on PISA and TIMSS—aligned pedagogies and assessment strategies for DepEd learners to participate in across the country. The pilot run will start with an orientation on November 17, 2021 and will involve weekly and monthly online challenges, culminating towards the National STEM Bee Finals in July 2022.

Relative to this, schools are encouraged to register and participate in the program. Registration will be until November 16, 2021. Please be informed that the project can only accommodate 50 schools with ten (10) learners allocated per school, and will thus employ a first come, first serve basis for the registration.
